# FROM NATIONAL TO EUROPEAN CAMPAIGN



Fatigue in health care is a challenge that has to be tackled across Europe.

The European Patient Safety Foundation <u>backed the UK #FightFatigue campaign in 2021</u>.

In close collaboration UK campaign team, developed collaborative campaign on European level -**FIGHTING FATIGUE TOGETHER t**o **accelerate change** by sharing the experience and tools from the UK campaign across Europe.

The campaign title was chosen to emphasise the long-term and collaborative aspect of the campaign at all levels:

- Collaboration at European level connecting organisations and individuals across Europe
- Collaboration at national level connecting organisations across country
- Collaboration in health care teams connecting individuals and encouraging teamwork

## **CAMPAIGN OBJECTIVES**



The general objective of the Fighting Fatigue Together Campaign (FFT) is to:

Reduce, across Europe, the negative impacts of healthcare staff fatigue on:

- the well-being and safety of the healthcare staff
- patient safety and quality of care
- the resilience of healthcare systems.


The **specific objectives** of the FFT Campaign are:

- 1. <u>Support</u> and reinforce the national FF communication campaigns led by national organisations or patient safety platforms
- 2. Integrate the national FF communication campaigns into a European FF dynamics
- 3. Offer visibility to the European dynamics
- 4. Support advocacy work in national or European organisations.



# **STREAM 2 - EMPOWER NATIONAL FIGHTING FATIGUE PLATFORMS**



In Europe, the local and national contexts vary:

- spoken language
- work culture
- legal frameworks
- etc

It will not be possible to reach the target audience across Europe without taking this variety into account. It's the work at **national level** that will make a difference.

#### Therefore, we need to:

- work closely together with partner organisations at national level: national PS societies, scientific societies (doctors, nurses), patient representative organisations, etc. They are the ones who can both reach the target audience of healthcare workers and refine the campaign messages and tools to make them more effective.
- invite national actors to cooperate by creating national teams
- align our messages content / visuals
- provide resources
- make the work efficient strategic planning


